Mr. Robert Savard, Resident Agent, FBI, Harrisburg, advised that a representative of the Wackenhut Corporation reported to the Philadelphia office that he had information indicating that Cosa Nostra would control the state dairy industry if Kapleau received the appointment as Chairman of the Milk Marketing Board.

Savard advised that as a result of this allegation, a brief investigation was made which indicated that Kapleau owned twenty shares of stock in Michael's Dairy in Philadelphia which is owned by the Maggio family.

He also advised that information had been received that Kapleau sold milk to the Central Dairy Product Sales Inc. who, in turn, hauled raw milk for Michael's Dairy. This milk from Central Dairy Product Sales allegedly was used by the Maggio Cheese Company.

He advised that other than the above, there was no information indicating any tie of Kapleau with organized crime.
