Robert Savard, FBI, Harrisburg, advised that the individual employed with Wackenhut in the Philadelphia area who furnished information indicating that Kapleau had some stock in Michael's Dairy was believed by the Wackenhut to have been a former FBI agent. It is believed he has the name of Bailey or something similar.

Savard advised that the information was apparently furnished on a confidential basis and that any attempt to locate this individual, who was employed by Wackenhut, should be made by a direct inquiry at the company offices of Wackenhut which are believed to be located at Bryn Mawr.

If Wackenhut is contacted concerning this matter, it should be handled on a basis to not indicate that any information had been received from the FBI.
