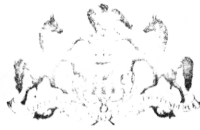
The Department of Justice, on June 5, 1973, turned over the results of its investigation of this matter to District Attorney Leroy S. Zimmerman's office.

As you are aware, you are in receipt of investigative reports, File No. 73-031, relative to fraudulent procurement activities committed by Michael A. Lauro and principals of Lafayette Radio and Electronics.

In addition to the above mentioned investigation, this office conducted two other investigations involving illegal purchases made by Lauro. These investigations are identified by File Numbers 73-010 and 73-038, copies of which are attached. File No. 73-010 covers 51 illegal purchases made by Lauro, totalling \$4,336.86, from 14 local vendors. File No. 73-038 covers illegal purchases of aircraft components and equipment, totalling \$2,539.47, made by Lauro.

It is respectfully requested that you initiate appropriate prosecutive action, with the assurance that full cooperation will be forthcoming from this office.
