
In response to your letter of 4 January 1974, kindly be advised that I am furnishing you with a copy of our Accident Investigation Report, Incident No. C1-16133, involving a Troop Car being operated by Lieutenant Angelo J. Carcaci.

As explained to you in previous correspondence, Lieutenant Carcaci will be suspended for five days for his negligent operation of the Troop Car.

Subsequent to this accident investigation, it was determined that Lieutenant Angelo J. Carcaci was not truthful to the investigating officer and failed to advise the investigating officer that he had another occupant in the vehicle.

We have since established the identity of the occupant and a supplemental report is forthcoming. Upon receipt of such supplemental report, a copy will be forwarded to you and your Committee.


Dear Captain:

Lieutenant Angelo Carcaci was involved in an automobile accident on December 16, 1973 at which time he suffered from multiple injuries:

Laceration left hand and scalp.
Trauma to the right shoulder.
Whiplash Injury.

He was admitted to the Adrian Hospital on January 3, 1974 because of a frozen right shoulder with constant pain and inability to use the right arm with severe persistent headache and pain on motion of his head and neck. X-rays revealed that he had a traumatic bursitis of the right shoulder along with the whiplash injury to the neck. He is being treated with medication and daily physiotherapy. His estimated period of disability will be approximately 6 weeks.



SUBJECT: Lieutenant Angelo J. Carcaci - Recommended Disciplinary
Action

1. Accident Report C1-16133 dated 16 December 73, with memorandum from Lieutenant Angelo J. Carcaci, and endorsement of the Commanding Officer, Troop C, Punxsutawney, and the Commander, Region 3, has been reviewed.

2. Approval is given for the imposition of a five-day suspension, without pay. However, the recommended Driver's Clinical Examination is disapproved. This special examination is for the purpose of determining the driving ability of those persons who have been involved in multiple accidents over a period of time. According to the report, Lt. Carcaci has not been involved in any other accidents. Nor is the Department permitted to require a member to pay for a Commonwealth vehicle.

3. Personnel Office will be notified at least two weeks in advance of the suspension dates.

4. Disciplinary Action Report, in triplicate, is being returned herewith for final action.
