CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I

Name of the Organization

Section 1. This organization shall be known as Fort Pitt Lodge No. 1, Fraternal Order of Police.

ARTICLE II

Object of the Organization

Section 1. This organization is formed for the purpose of bettering existing conditions of Policemen.

Section 2. For advancing social, benevolent, charitable and educational undertaking among Policemen.

ARTICLE III

Membership

Section 1. All Police Officers engaged in full-time Police work for the City of Pittsburgh shall be eligible to membership in this Lodge.

Section 2. Race, Creed or Sex shall be no bar to membership.

Section 3. Any Police Officer actively engaged in full-time police work for the City of Pittsburgh, desiring membership in this organization, shall make application in writing to the Financial Secretary. The Financial Secretary shall read all new applications for membership at a regular meeting and then turn them over to the Membership Committee for their deliberation and consideration, after which they shall be reported back to the floor with the committee's recommendations.
