FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, Lodge No. 1 State Police Civic Association Commission on Charitable Solicitations Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge No. 91

On January 4, 1974, Miss Carol Cochran, Director of Commission on Charitable Solicitations, advised that her staff is continuing to investigate the FOP lodges and other police-related agencies to include the professional solicitors involved. She has filed only one complaint as a result of the information this Committee previously furnished. The complaint involved the Fort Pitt Lodge, No. 1, along with the solicitor relating to that lodge. Miss Cochran made available two copies of the complaint which are being attached to this memorandum and are self-explanatory.

She has provided the Attorney General's Office with information regarding FOP, Lodge No. 91, as well as the Pennsylvania Chiefs of Police Association, however, to date, no complaint has been filed. She believes the Attorney General is waiting to see the developments in the Fort Pitt Lodge case before proceeding.

Miss Cochran advised that the State Police Civic Association filed appropriate papers with her organization for registration during the summer of 1973. The application was not approved at that time because it failed to contain all of the required data. She does not recall specifically, but believed that sometime after the disapproval of this application, Mr. Zinsky informed her that the State Police Civic Association was not going to solicit and, therefore, they were not going to pursue the registration. However, in November 1973, Mr. Zinsky forwarded to her office another application requesting approval for the State Police Civic Association. This request is set forth in a letter, dated October 25, 1973, which is being attached as part of this memorandum.

Miss Cochran said she replied to the second application by telling Mr. Zinsky that it could not be approved at this point because the annual report had not been properly completed. This disapproval is set forth in a letter, dated November 14, 1973, from Miss Cochran to the State Police Civic Association and is being attached as part of this memorandum.

According to Miss Cochran, the State 48fice Civic Association application has not been approved to date.

Also attached to this memorandum are letters dated August 8, 1973 from Zinsky to Miss Cochran, along with a letter, dated August 13, 1973, which contains a reply from Miss Cochran to Zinsky regarding the application.

It should be noted that Joseph T. Mullen, Special Agent, Pennsylvania Bureau of Investigation, Department of Justice, has been loaned to Miss Cochran to undertake investigations pertaining to the FOP lodges and others regarding registrations with the Charitable Solicitations Act.

Mr. Mullen came into the office this date and desired to have information that we have collected regarding Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge No.5. It was pointed out that such information could be made available at a later date; however, at the present time, certain areas of investigation pertinent to this Committee are pending and we, therefore, feel it inappropriate to divulge the information regarding FOP Lodge No. 5 at this time.

On March 20, 1974, I telephonically contacted Miss Carol Cochran, Director of the Commission on Charitable Solicitations (telephone No. 783–1720), and she furnished the following information:

- 1. A hearing was held on January 21 or 28 concerning Lodge #91 as to whether the Lodge has to register with the Commission.
- 2. The attorney for FOP Lodge #5, ANTHONY J. PIRILLO, acknowledged Miss Cochran's letter of August 2, 1973 indicating that the members of the Lodge were out of town for a convention and asked for an extension of two weeks. Since then she has heard nothing from the Lodge.
- 3. The Attorney General's Office has advised that until the suit against FOP Lodge #91 is settled, there is no reason to proceed against the other lodges in the state.
- 4. Several FOP Lodges have come forward and attempted to register; however, because of the above advice from the Attorney General's Office, those applications are being held in abeyance.
- 5. Miss Cochran has heard nothing further from the State Police Civic Association since her letter of November 14, 1973 advising that the information furnished in the State Police Civic Association letter of October 25, 1973 was inadequate.
