FILE:           Boroughs and Townships Police Association

On July 12, 1973, Herbert Halsband, Hal-Fran Associates, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, made available records to the Committee pertaining to the Boroughs and Townships Police Association, Allegheny Chiefs of Police Association, and Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge No. 91.

A review of the records for the Boroughs and Townships Police Association shows that on January 11, 1969, Hal-Fran entered into a contract agreement to handle the sale and solicitation of the Boroughs and Townships annual dance and associate membership program. The contract specifies that it will be a 65/35% arrangement whereby Hal-Fran would realize 65% of the gross monies and, at the same time, guarantee an associate membership program of \$35,000. The records show that the gross receipts for the period of March 1972 through June 1973 total \$61,219.50. The amount realized by Hal-Fran for the same period is \$39,801.55. //

Mr. Halsband made available detailed records showing the name of the contributor, along with the amount, for the period of December 21, 1972 through July 5, 1973.

FILE: Allegheny County Chiefs of Police Association

Mr. Halsband made available a copy of a contract that his company has with the Allegheny County Chiefs of Police Association, Inc. The contract is neither dated nor signed, however, it appears to cover the period of December 1974 through 1977. This contract sets forth a 65/35% arrangement, with Hal-Fran receiving the greater percentage. This contract states that the purpose of the agreement is to produce funds for the pension and benefit programs and for other similar programs and undertakings of the Allegheny County Chiefs of Police.

Mr. Halsband made available the detailed records which show the name of the contributor, along with the amount, for the period of March 1972 through July 5, 1973. The detailed records are actually statements prepared by Halsband for the Chiefs of Police Association and outline the cash amount, as well as checks, received on behalf of the Allegheny County Chiefs of Police Association. The total amount collected for this period of time exceeds \$69,000.

FILE: Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge No. 91

Mr. Halsband made available records for review concerning FOP Lodge No. 91. One record was a contract dated March 15, 1972, whereby Hal-Fran Associates agreed to perform the sponsorship of their annual dance and guaranteed a collection of \$22,000. The percentage arrangement was 65/35, with Hal-Fran receiving the greater amount. Another record was the contract whereby Hal-Fran would perform the associate membership drive on behalf of Lodge No. 91 and guaranteed a gross sale of \$23,000.

The terms of these contracts were for 1972 through 1975, with an automatic renewal clause for an additional three years. The percentage arrangement was 65/35 with Hal-Fran realizing the greater. Both of these contracts are valid.

According to Hal-Fran, the associate membership gross receipts for the period of March 1972 through June 1973 exceeded \$89,000. Of this amount, Lodge No. 91 received in excess of \$30,000, while Hal-Fran realized in excess of \$58,000. The dance figures are not available.

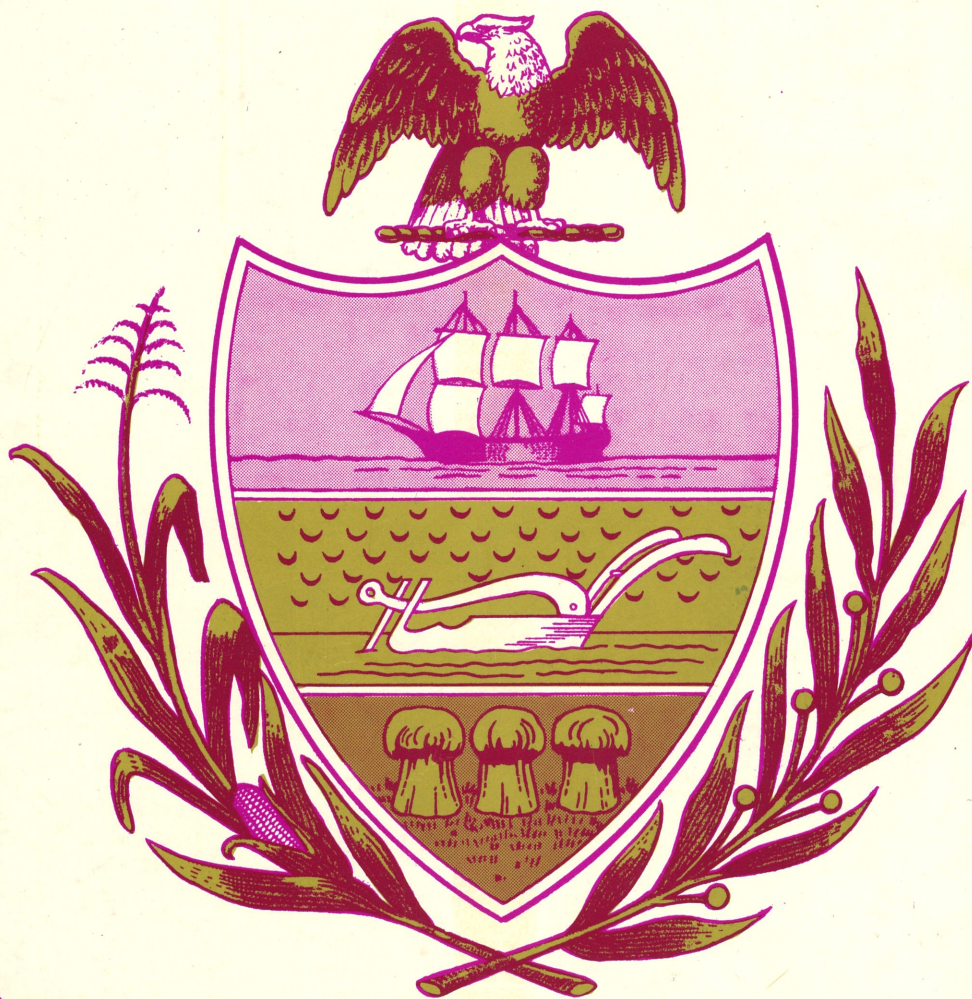
