You will also note that according to our Bylaws there are no paid employees of this Association.

We are pleased to note in our Conference Report that we as an Association are very much involved in educational programs for our members, as well as coordinating and providing community services wherever we can make same available by contributing of monies or volunteer personal counsel.

As you will note, most Chief County Detectives in the State belong to our organization and though all County Detectives are not members we feel our program provides service to them through the office of the Chief.

At the present time our Secretary-Treasurer, Mr. Thomas Frame, is on vacation and I cannot give you the exact amount of money in our treasury and or a copy of our financial report from Tubobs Associates, but this will be made available to you sometime next week.

At this time I have a 1972 ad book available (being sent under separate cover) and our 1973 ad book I am advised is in the process of being printed (can be verified) and will be available in the near future.

I am enclosing a copy of the agreement with Tubobs Associates, which you will note gives either party the prerogative of cancelling within ninety (90) days of said term.

It is my opinion, and the opinion of the officers and members of this Association that the County Detectives Association receives in addition to the 35% many supplementary things from Tubobs that are cost factors, such as, photography services, programming services, secretarial services, telephone and communication services (over and above the day to day telephone and communication service involved in the solicitation by Tubobs for the purpose of public support of our organization).

I think at the present time this is all the information you asked for, and I will forward to you upon Mr. Frame's return the gross amount in the treasury and other financial information as per our 1973 treasurer's report.

Gentlemen:

This letter constitutes an agreement between our organization, Tubobs Associates, Inc. and the County Detectives Association of Pennsylvania, for the purpose of publishing your annual yearbook and the solicitation of advertising therein.

This agreement shall run for a period of five (5) years commencing from the 2nd day of May 1971 (May 2, 1971).

It is agreed that County Detectives Association of Pennsylvania, is to receive Thirty Five (35%) per cent of the gross advertising revenue obtained and the balance of Sixty Five (65%) per cent of said gross revenue is to be paid to Tubobs Associates, Inc. As set forth above, Tubobs Associates, Inc. shall pay for all expenses related to the publishing and circulation of said yearbook from its share of the revenue proceeds as set forth in this paragraph. Tubobs Associates, Inc. agrees to distribute to the County Detectives Association of Pennsylvania, yearbooks for the entire membership. Tubobs Associates, Inc. will also supply the advertisers with yearbooks. All advertising revenue obtained by Tubobs Associates, Inc. shall be paid directly to the Treasurer of County Detectives Association of Pennsylvania, who shall then, on a weekly basis, pay to Tubobs Associates, Inc. their proportionate share of the advertising revenue.

Tubobs Associates Inc. agrees to instruct its employees to conduct the solicitation of this yearbook on the highest possible levels, which would be in keeping with the traditions of the County Detectives Association of Pennsylvania.

All the conditions of this agreement are contained herein in this letter to which you will sign your acceptance.

It is hereby agreed that either party hereto may terminate this agreement at the end of said term by giving to the other party ninety (90) days written notice prior thereto, but in default of such notice, this agreement shall continue upon the same terms and conditions in force for a further period of five (5) years and so on from year to year, unless or until terminated, by either party hereto giving the other ninety (90) days written notice.
