

Dear Mr. Selfridge:

I am enclosing the correspondence we discussed on the telephone. In addition, Mr. Stryke has reported that the solicitor who called on behalf of the Association, identified himself as "Sergeant McLaughlin". He told Mr. Stryke that "six of Philadelphia's finest" were being pulled off the streets to man telephones to solicit for this "cause" because the returns from mailings have been so disappointing.

The enclosed copies of a letter and proposal received by Mr. Stryke were accompanied by stickers for cars and so-called courtesy cards for wallets.

Mr. Stryke's office checks all solicitations received through the Better Business Bureau. They have made it clear on several occasions that they are only too glad to support the police in every way and will continue to do so as long as they can be assured that the lion's share of the money solicited reaches the policemen who are to be benefited. They will refuse, however, to support any solicitation emanating from a professional promoter who receives more than 15% of the amount contributed.

The telephone number listed on the proposal, GA6-0121, indicates to us that the solicitation is being made from 2015 E. Allegheny Ave., the address of a professional promoter who handles many of the solicitations for fraternal groups.

Thank you for your interest in this matter. I shall look forward to hearing from you.


