The House Committee already knows but is not doing anything about getting testimony from a Sergeant Angelo Carcaci of the State Police who is skilled in tapping telephone lines and did, at least, the following tapping;

- (1) tapped lines with Commissioner Barger in 1966 in Butler County of a group of Black leaders. During the job, the telephone pole broke.
- (2) tapped lines with Sergeant Hunt in 1966 in Altoona of gamblers.
- (3) fixed a tapping transmitter in the Harrisburg home of Captain Titler in 1966.

Sergeant Carcaci has a photostat of the mileage report of the special truck used for tapping operations in 1966 and has showed this paper to other people.

Sergeant Carcaci can not claim the Fifth when asked about this since the statute of limitations has passed since all of the above concern 1966 acts.

Sergeant Carcaci discussed the above 3 incidents and also displayed the photostat of the mileage report to 5 people in Harrisburg(or nearby) in early 1973. All 5 people are reputable citizens and will testify about that meeting with Sgt. Carcaci IF he denies any of the above information.
