Mr. L. A. PETRUCCIO, Comptroller, Department of Justice, advised on April 26, 1974 that up until fiscal year 1971 federal and state funds available to the Pennsylvania Crime Commission were commingled for accounting purposes at the Comptroller's level. In fiscal year 1971, a correction voucher was used to charge the Bureau of Investigations, Department of Justice, with the salary of DEAN SHEAFFER who was actually on the payroll of the Pennsylvania Crime Commission. Beginning in fiscal year 1972, the Pennsylvania Crime Commission had Appropriation 09 and the Bureau of Investigations remained in Appropriation 81. Beginning this year, it was necessary for the Comptroller to use an Appropriation Expenditure Adjustment in order to charge the Bureau of Investigations with Mr. Sheaffer's salary.

Mr. Petruccio made available the attached correspondence which reflects that even though Dean Sheaffer was on the payroll of the Pennsylvania Crime Commission until June 30, 1973, his salary was actually paid out of the Bureau of Investigations, Department of Justice, funds.
