Pennsylvania Crime Commission

The files of the Governor's Justice Commission and interviews with Commission personnel reveal the following:

DA-014-70

Awarded July 20, 1970 for \$453,000 from July 1, 1970 to June 30, 1971. Later extended to June 30, 1972.

Statewide investigation and exposure of organized crime and official corruption, maintenance of a statewide organized crime intelligence center, development of recommendations for legislative and administrative actions to improve Pennsylvania Criminal Justice System, etc.

DS-187-71A

Awarded February 7, 1972 for \$330,000 for period February 1, 1972 to June 30, 1972. Later extended to February 7, 1973.

330,000

To provide continued funding for DA-014-70.

DS-295-72A

Awarded September 11, 1972 for \$775,000 for period September 1972 to June 1973.

775,000

A continuation of funding provided by DS-187-71A.

DS-389-73A

Awarded June 4, 1973 for \$751,000 for period July 1, 1973 to June 30, 1974 to continue funding prior project (DS-295-72A). Extended to September 30, 1974.

Awarded March 4, 1974 for \$110,000 for period April 1, 1974 to June 30, 1974 to augment funding provided under DS-389-73A.

DS-409-73A

Awarded July 16, 1973 for \$1,709 to send nine members of staff to first National Advanced Organized Crime Seminar to be held in New Orleans, La. July 22-25, 1973.

DS-464-73A

Awarded April 1, 1974 for \$37,400 to publish 10,000 copies of the Crime Commission's Report on Police Corruption and the Quality of Law Enforcement in Philadelphia.
