Dear Faith:


Thank God you were elected.

Attorney General Younger has asked me to acknowledge and thank you for expressing interest in the rape evidence law in your recent letter.

In regard to your request for information, you may find the enclosed material helpful.

The enclosed Senate Bill, being chaptered, is law, although as yet unincorporated in the codes.

The Assembly Bills are law, being signed into law by the Governor on or about September 23, 1974. They have not as yet been chaptered.

The Penal Code sections have been enclosed for your convenience.
