On Tuesday, July 23, I received a call from the office of Senator Austin Murphy inquiring about a Committee subpoena which had been issued to one of his constituents, Harold "Goose" Mitchell, PennDOT highway superintendent for Greene County.

The subpoena duces tecum issued to Mitchell was to be returned the following day and contained two certain personal incorporate records in his possession. Senator Murphy inquired whether or not Mr. Mitchell was required to personally appear with said records.

I read him the subpoena, which was self evident and the telephone call was terminated. Senator Murphy was very cordial during his conversation and he repeatedly explained that he was making the inquiry only on behalf of his constituent's request.
