As counsel to Gulf Insurance Company, we herewith submit the documents requested in your subpoena duces tecum to Custodian of Records, Gulf Insurance Company dated September 25, 1974.

As is recited in our letter to you dated September 30, 1974, you had granted our request for an extension of time of one (1) week for this submission, <u>i.e.</u>, to date of October 8, 1974.

On July 9, 1974, in response to a proper subpoena issued by the Grand Jury of the U.S. District Court of the Western District of Pennsylvania, the entire file of the Gulf Insurance Company with reference to Policies No. GA5-36-00-93, and No. GA5-53-18-91 were given into the custody of the said Grand Jury. In response to this Committee's subpoena, dated September 25, 1974, the file in the custody of the U.S. Grand Jury was examined on October 2, 1974, in order to obtain copies of the documents requested by this Committee. These documents are herewith submitted.
