As is recited in our letter to you dated September 30, 1974, you had granted our request for an extension of time of one (1) week for this submission, i.e., to date of October 8, 1974.

On July 9, 1974, in response to a proper subpoena issued by the Grand Jury of the U.S. District Court of the Western District of Pennsylvania, the entire file of the Gulf Insurance Company with reference to Policies No. GA5-36-00-93, and No. GA5-53-18-91 were given into the custody of the said Grand Jury.
