2. Non-Personnel Expenses of Select Committee

Stenographic and transcription services are provided through the Office of the Chief Clerk and to the best of my knowledge billed to same with the records being maintained by the Chief Clerk.

As of this date no witness fess have been requested or incurred by the Committee.

Expenses incurred by the field investigators have been submitted by the individual investigator through the office of the Majority Leader. I understand that this is the standard House procedure.
