Also enclosed is a photographic copy of an application to the Pennsylvania Insurance Department for a Resident Agent License without examination.

You will note this application was sworn to by the personal signature of Anthony J. Trucco before a Harriet M. Trucco, Notary Public on May 5, 1972. The Reserve Insurance Company provided its required endorsement of Mr. Trucco on June 9, 1972 and it was approved by the Insurance Department on June 13, 1972, at which time Mr. Trucco's license as a Resident Agent with Reserve became effective.

Aside from Mr. Trucco's charges against the Insurance Department contained in the statement, would you please notify me immediately of your intentions regarding this incident in which it appears there is another violation of your "code of ethics."
