HOUSE SELECT COMMITTEE ON PROPERTY TAX MINUTES NOVEMBER 29, 2012

Chairman Quigley called the meeting of the House Select Committee on Property Tax to order at 11:52 a.m. on Thursday, November 29, 2012, in Room 60 of the East Wing.

The following members were present:

The purpose of the meeting was to consider the Report of the Committee, which is required by House Resolution 774.

Chairman Quigley made opening remarks and then allowed members of the Committee to make statements regarding the Report of the Committee.

Representative Brown stated that there is a need for property tax reform and said she would be casting an affirmative vote on the report. She added that the report is a compromise and said she is not fully satisfied with the language in the report concerning the distribution of school funding. She further added that it is her hope that legislative efforts will focus on a fairer formula. She concluded by thanking members and staff for their time and efforts on the property tax reform issue.

Representative Dean also thanked members and staff for their efforts on this very important issue. She expressed a desire to keep this work going, as she said the Committee was on its way to good ideas. She added that she would like to see in the draft conclusion a recommendation to pass a new resolution to re-establish the committee in the next legislative session.

It was agreed that after the Committee's recess, a motion would be taken up recommending that the Committee be reconstituted in the next legislative session. The Committee recessed at 12:00 noon until 1:00 p.m.

The Committee reconvened its meeting at 1:37 p.m. to review the draft of the final report of the Committee.

Representative Dean made a motion that the Committee be re-established in the new legislative session by way of a House resolution. After consulting with House legal staff, Chairman

Quigley asked Representative Dean if she would agree to withdraw her motion and add her suggestion to the report as a recommendation. Without objection, the suggestion was added to the Committee's list of recommendations in the final report.

Chairman Quigley announced that a final draft of the report would be prepared with the agreed-to revisions and that the Committee would return at 2 p.m. for a final vote. The Committee recessed its meeting at 1:40 p.m.

The Committee reconvened at 2:25 p.m. and everyone was provided with a clean draft of the report.

Representative Swanger requested some minor corrections to the report which were agreed to without objection. She also expressed concern that House Bill 1776 was not listed somewhere in the recommendations. Chairman Quigley said that the report alludes to House Bill 1776, as one of the recommendations calls for the General Assembly to direct an independent entity or entities to study the fiscal impact of property tax relief up to and including property tax elimination at various levels of income.

Representative Swanger noted there had been quite a bit of narrative about reassessment in the report and questioned why it had been taken out. Chairman Quigley indicated that a consensus could not be reached on the wording.

Vice Chairman Briggs, Representative Dean and Representative Swanger each said they would be submitting comments to be added as addenda to the final report.

By a unanimous vote of 12-0, the Report of the Committee was adopted with Vice Chairman Briggs as the sponsor of the motion and Representative Simmons seconding.

Chairman Quigley thanked members and staff for their effort and work in this process. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:45 p.m.
