As per your request, the following information pertains to the cleaning of the statues at the front steps to the Capitol Building.

Dependent upon our personnel situation at the time, we have tentatively scheduled the subject cleaning to begin the week of June 16, 1980.

Cleaning Agent

Parts ammonia to water; parts sulphuric acid to water. Normally 10 parts of water to 1 part ammonia - and 10 parts of water to 1 part sulphuric acid.

Sealing Agent

Incralac

Mr. Donald Winer of the State Historical and Museum Commission advised the use of the above Agents and has also indicated that he will make himself available for advice when the work begins.
