KENNETH E. BRANDT

Kenneth E. Brandt was born in Lancaster County on November 17, 1938. A graduate of Elizabethtown Area High School and a member of the First Church of God, Representative Brandt is married to Jean Marie Brandt and they have five children. Prior to being elected to the Pennsylvania House of Representatives, he served on the Elizabethtown Area School Board for three years and was active in the Elizabethtown Jaycees, in which he served on the local level, state level and as National Director. His present civic involvement includes membership in the Elizabethtown Rotary Club, the F. and A.M. Lodge No. 286 and Corinthian Royal Arch Chapter No. 224 in Columbia PA.

Representative Brandt was first elected to the House in 1973 and is currently serving his eighth consecutive term. From 1973 through 1980 he served on the following committees: Agriculture, Appropriation, Consumer Affairs, Law and Justice, Local Government and State Government. In 1981 Representative Brandt was elected Chairman of the House Majority Policy Committee, a leadership position, and presently serves as Chairman of the Republican Policy Committee and Chairman of the House Republican Campaign Committee. In this current session Representative Brandt has prime sponsored several bills to bring about meaningful tort reform in Pennsylvania.
