HOUSE BILL 1056, P.N. 3019; This bill when enacted shall be known as the "Pennsylvania Farmland and Forest Land Assessment Act of 1974", (clean and green) and shall prescribe the procedure under which an owner may have land devoted to agricultural use, agricultural reserve use, or forest reserve use, valued for tax purposes at the value it has for such uses, and providing for reassessment and certain interest payments when such land is applied to other uses.

Land devoted to agricultural use, agricultural reserve, and/or forest reserve may be valued for property tax purposes at the value of its use if:

1. The agricultural land has been used for agriculture during the preceding three (3) years and is at least ten contiguous acres or has an anticipated annual gross income of two thousand dollars (\$2,000).
2. The land is ten contiguous acres or more and is used for an agricultural reserve.
3. The land devoted for forest reserves is at least ten contiguous acres, and the assessor determines the value based on a soil survey.

The County Board of Assessment and Revision of Taxes shall accept and process the applications for preferential assessments. The Department of Agriculture shall prepare uniform forms for preferential assessments.

Land removed from preferential assessment treatment due to use, shall be taxed at the regular rate plus the difference between that amount paid in the previous nine (9) years and the amount payable if a regular valuation and assessment was in effect. Interest on this roll back tax would be at a rate of six percent (6%) per year.

HOUSE BILL 1056, P.N. 2775; Weidner amendment, 4/16/74 (unanimous). This amendment allows counties that have agreements with landowners, based on 1965 P.L. 1292, Act No. 515 for preservation of open spaces to renegotiate those agreements if they choose to, based on this act.

HOUSE BILL 1056, P.N. 2888; Pitts amendment, 4/23/74 (unanimous). This amendment charges the minimum anticipated yearly gross from \$1,000 to \$2,000 for agricultural land use to be eligible for preferential treatment if it is not at least ten contiguous acres.

HOUSE BILL 1056, P.N. 2888; Pitts amendment, 4/23/74, (unanimous). The amendment gives the landowner rather than the county the option to renegotiate Act No. 515.

HOUSE BILL 1056, P.N. 2888; Foster amendment, 4/23/74, (unanimous). These amendments made technical editorial changes in language.

HOUSE BILL 1056, P.N. 2973; Thomas amendment, 4/29/74 (Part 1, 98-86 and 96-85; Part II, 78-106). Part I of the amendment defines "Farmer-owner-operator" and adds a subsection to exempt from the roll back taxes land split off from preferential assessments when that land remains eligible under the act. Part II of the amendment would limit roll back taxes for agricultural land from a ten (10) year period to a five (5) year period.

PROS

1. This language reduces the chance for abuse by land speculators.
2. The amendment protects the farmer who may be forced to sell a portion of his land to sustain his farm.
3. The agricultural community will participate in the program only if they have the protection of Part I of the amendment.

CONS

1. The bill as it exists will protect the individual who wants to farm in a land area with a high market value.
2. The amendment would make agricultural productive land vulnerable.
3. Giving preferential split-offs would hinder the farmers.
4. Part II of the amendment is inequitable in that when a profit is taken on the land, the owner should pay back the taxes he has been given preferable treatment for.
5. Part I destroys the goal of keeping agricultural land in agricultural production.
