1. House Bill 61	Metzgar		House Bill 61 amends title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) concerning the collection of court costs, restitution, and fines.
2. House Bill 1203	Lawrence		House Bill 1203 amends the Vehicle Code to permit owners of antique or classic vehicles to display vintage Pennsylvania license plates from the year of the manufacture of the vehicle as their official plate.
3. House Bill 1416	Evankovich		House Bill 1416 requires the Department of Environmental Protection to submit annual reports relating to certain restricted accounts in the State Treasury. This bill shall take effect in 60 days upon enactment.
4. House Bill 1544	Christiana		House Bill 1544 amends the Vital Statistics Law providing for a death certificate without the cause of death listed. Effective date June 30, 2012 or immediately whichever is later.
5. House Bill 1548	Murt		House Bill 1548 amends the Child Labor Law (Act 177 of 1915) to rewrite the section of the law that deals with participation of minors in entertainment work. This legislation would take effect October 1, 2011.
6. House Bill 1644	Dunbar		House Bill 1644 amends the County Code to allow the sale of city personal property through electronic auctions. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.
7. Senate Bill 326	Corman		Senate Bill 326 amends the Vital Statistics Law of 1953 providing for a Certificate of Birth resulting in Stillbirth. Effective date is in 60 days.
8. Senate Bill 369	D. White		Senate Bill 369 amends the Transportation Code to designate several connecting scenic byways. This legislation would take effect immediately.
9. Senate Bill 606	Robbins		Senate Bill 606 designates a 37-mile portion of roadway in Crawford County, passing through Pymatuning State Park, the Pymatuning Reservoir and paralleling Conneaut Lake, as a scenic byway as the Crawford Lakelands Byway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

10. Senate Bill 858	Waugh		Senate Bill 858 amends Article X of the Public School Code concerning District Superintendents and Assistant Superintendents. It would take effect in 60 days.
11. Senate Bill 1055	Corman		Senate Bill 1055 makes an appropriation of \$27,320,000 from the State Employees' Retirement Fund to provide for the expenses incurred by the State Employees' Retirement Board for the administration of the system for the fiscal year July 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.

Senate Bill 1056	Corman		Senate Bill 1056 makes an appropriation of \$44,107,000 from the Public School Employees' Retirement Fund to provide for the expenses incurred by the Public School Employees' Retirement Board for the administration of the system for the fiscal year July 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.
13. Senate Bill 1057	Corman		Senate Bill 1057 appropriates a total of \$43,875,000 from restricted revenue accounts in the General Fund to the Department of State. This legislation would take effect July 1, 2011, or immediately, whichever is later.
14. Senate Bill 1058	Corman		Senate Bill 1058 appropriates \$ 82,184,000 from the Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry and to the Office of Small Business Advocate. This legislation would take effect July 1, 2011, or immediately, whichever is later.

Senate Bill 1059	Corman		Senate Bill 1059 makes an appropriation of \$58,898,000 from the restricted revenue account within the General Fund to the Public Utility Commission for general government operations for the fiscal year July, 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012. This appropriation represents a decrease in funding of \$11,000, or 0.2% from the current year. Funds in the restricted revenue account are derived from assessments on utilities regulated by the Public Utility Commission.
17. Senate Bill 1061	Corman		Senate Bill 1061 makes an appropriation of \$1,092,000 from the restricted revenue account within the General Fund to the Office of Small Business Advocate in the Department of Community and Economic Development for general government operations for the fiscal year July, 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012. This appropriation represents an increase in funding of \$31,000, or 2.9% from the current year. Funds in the restricted revenue account are derived from assessments on utilities regulated by the Public Utility Commission.

Senate Bill 1062	Corman	Markosek Amendment	Senate Bill 1062 appropriates of \$62,823,000 from the restricted revenue account within the State Gaming Fund to the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board, the Attorney General, the Department of Revenue, and the Pennsylvania State Police for salaries, wages and all necessary expenses relating to gaming for the fiscal year July, 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012. This amount represents a decrease in funding of \$2,196,000, or 3.4% from the current year. Funds in the restricted revenue accounts are derived from assessments on licensed gaming facilities.
