Brief Description

Senate Bill 1062 appropriates of \$62,823,000 from the restricted revenue account within the State Gaming Fund to the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board, the Attorney General, the Department of Revenue, and the Pennsylvania State Police for salaries, wages and all necessary expenses relating to gaming for the fiscal year July, 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012. This amount represents a decrease in funding of \$2,196,000, or 3.4% from the current year. Funds in the restricted revenue accounts are derived from assessments on licensed gaming facilities.


