House Bill 973	Kula		House Bill 973 amends the Vital Statistics Law by adding language stating funeral director or funeral establishments must determine if cremated remains in their possession are those of a veteran, and requires proper notification and release of remains to a veterans' service organization if unclaimed. This bill shall take effect in 60 days upon enactment.
2. House Bill 1307	Milne		House Bill 1307 amends various sections of the Public School Code concerning subsidies for services, financial reports, salaries, the wearing of military uniforms at graduation ceremonies, and audits of school districts. It would take effect in 60 days.
3. House Bill 1363	Rapp		House Bill 1363 amends Sections 1205.1 and 1205.2 concerning continuing professional development. It would take effect in 60 days.
