5. Senate Bill 163	Baker		Designates a bridge on that portion of SR 6 over the Lackawaxen River, Honesdale Borough, Wayne County as the Brigadier General Richard J. Tallman Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.
6. Senate Bill 263	Erickson		Senate Bill 263 requires the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (IRRC) to consider whether a regulation is based on and supported by empirical, replicable and testable data. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.
7. Senate Bill 723	Yaw		Senate Bill 723 designates the bridge that connects South Williamsport to Williamsport, known as the Market Street Bridge, carrying U.S. Route 15 over the Susquehanna River in Loyalsock Township, Lycoming County, as the Carl E. Stotz Memoral Little League Bridge.
