1. House Bill 511	Sponsor Hennessey	ments	House Bill 511 amends the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, in health and accident insurance, providing for access to community pharmacy services.
2. House Bill 1769	Farry		House Bill 1769 amends the Judicial Code concerning criminal laboratory user fees. It would take effect in 60 days.
3. House Bill 1960	Vulakovich		House Bill 1960 amends the Prescribed Pediatric Extended Care Centers Act changing the age limit from 8 years to 21 years of age effective immediately.
4. Senate Bill 242	Kasunic		Senate Bill 242 designates State Route 601 over Barclay Run in the Borough of Somerset, Somerset County as the Trooper Stephen R. Gyurke Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.
5. Senate Bill 732	Vance		Senate Bill 732 amends the Health Care Facilities Act adding a definition for abortion facility and providing for licensure of abortion facilities. Effective date is in 180 days.
6. Senate Bill 1183	Orie		Senate Bill 1183 makes numerous changes to the Crimes Code, Prisons and Parole Code, Domestic Relations, Law and Justice, and Judicial Code to substantially comply with the federal Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006 and to close the loopholes in Megan's Law regarding homeless offenders and out-of-state offenders who must register for a lifetime in their home states.
