7. House Bill 2158	Grell		House Bill 2158 designates the bridge carrying State Route 114 over Interstate 81 in Silver Spring Township, Cumberland County, as the Corporal Paul Walters Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.
8. House Bill 2192	Quinn		House Bill 2192 designates a bridge on US Route 202 in Doylestown Township, Bucks County in Honor of First Lieutenant Colby J. Umbrell. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.
