Senate Bill 1433	Gordner		Senate Bill 1433 creates the freestanding Homeowner Assistance Settlement Act to direct funding for the Homeowner's Emergency Mortgage Assistance Program (HEMAP) and provides a timeframe for challenging a mortgage foreclosure as per Act 91 notification. This legislation would take effect immediately with provisions related to noncompliance with notice requirements retroactive to June 5, 1999.
8. Senate Bill 1478	Corman		Senate Bill 1478 appropriates \$81,896,000 from the Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry and to the Office of Small Business Advocate. This legislation would take effect July 1, 2012, or immediately, whichever is later.
