1. House Bill 1539	Saylor		House Bill 1539 establishes the Keystone Works Program. This legislation would take effect immediately but would expire June 30, 2017.
2. House Bill 1803	Caltagirone		House Bill 1803 permits third class cities that have parking authorities to assign enforcement and administration of parking laws to the parking authority; amends language relating to the Philadelphia Parking Authority (PPA); and extends Philadelphia's red light camera pilot program until December 31, 2016. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

House Bill 1820	Delozier		House Bill 1820 provides an exemption to overtime pay requirements for hospitals and other health care establishments; and permits air carriers to work more than 40 hours/week, without being paid overtime, through voluntary agreement amongst employees. Senate Bill 1433	Gordner		Senate Bill 1433 creates the freestanding Homeowner Assistance Settlement Act to direct funding for the Homeowner's Emergency Mortgage Assistance Program (HEMAP) and provides a timeframe for challenging a mortgage foreclosure as per Act 91 notification. This legislation would take effect immediately with provisions related to noncompliance with notice requirements retroactive to June 5, 1999.
8. Senate Bill 1478	Corman		Senate Bill 1478 appropriates \$81,896,000 from the Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry and to the Office of Small Business Advocate. This legislation would take effect July 1, 2012, or immediately, whichever is later.
