4. Senate Bill 1465	Dinniman		Senate Bill 1465 designates a portion of State Route 3 in Chester County as the Senator Robert J. Thompson Highway; and a bridge on Pottstown Pike in Chester County as the Representative Sam Morris and Eleanor Morris Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.
5. Senate Bill 1535	Greenleaf		Senate Bill 1535 amends the Judicial Code concerning rules of evidence and medical records. It would take effect in 60 days.
6. Senate Bill 1546	Gordner		Senate Bill 1546 adds a chapter relating to the State Tax Equalization Board to the Community and Economic Development Enhancement Act (Act 58 of 1996) and repeals the State Tax Equalization Board Law (Act 447 of 1947). This legislation would take effect immediately.
7. Senate Bill 1551	Greenleaf		Senate Bill 1551 designates 8.6 miles of the U.S. Route 202 Parkway between State Route 63 and State Route 611 as a scenic byway; and designates a bridge on the Parkway over State Route 309 as the Chief Richard J. Brady Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.
