| 2. House Bill 2409 | Ellis | | House Bill 2409 creates the Costs of Care of Seized Animals Act. This legislation would take effect in 60 days. |
| 3. House Bill 2480 | Quinn | | House Bill 2480 amends the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act by adding a new section-Ephedrine and Pseudoephedrine; Electronic Tracking. The effective date is in 9 months. |
| 4. House Bill 2536 | Marshall | | House Bill 2536 repeals the act of December 14, 1967 (P.L.746, No.345), known as the Savings Association Code of 1967. |
| 5. House Bill 2591 | Godshall | | House Bill 2591 amends Titles 51 (Military Affairs) and 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the calculation of military members' State Employees' Retirement System (SERS) benefits. The effective date is December 31, 2012. |
| 6. House Bill 2626 | Benninghoff | | House Bill 2626 creates a freestanding act establishing the Promoting Employment Across Pennsylvania Program providing tax benefits to qualified companies in the form of withholding tax relief. |
| 7. Senate Bill 341 | Greenleaf | | Senate Bill 341 authorizes the Department of Agriculture to establish an Automotive Fuel Testing and Disclosure Program. This legislation would take effect in 30 days. |
| 8. Senate Bill 623 | Tomlinson | | Senate Bill 623 amends Title 51 (Military Affairs) to establish a program for assisting veteran-owned businesses to obtain state contracts. This legislation would take effect in 60 days. |
| 9. Senate Bill 1147 | Argall | | Senate Bill 1147 amends the Vehicle Code establishing hauling permits for the movement of eggs and for the transport of cryogenic liquid on specified highways. The legislation further provides for employer responsibilities, commercial driver's licenses, requirements for commercial vehicles when approaching railroad crossings, uniformity of title, and disposition of the liquid fuels and fuels tax. This legislation would take effect in 60 days. |
| 10. Senate Bill 1345 | Folmer | | Senate Bill 1345 creates a freestanding act providing for streamlined procedures for reviewing applications for the modification or collocation of wireless communications facilities and wireless support structures. |
| 11. Senate Bill 1480 | Corman | | Senate Bill 1480 provides for the Capital Budget Act of 2012-13. This legislation would take effect July 1, 2012, or immediately, whichever is later. |
