This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days and apply to all elections occurring after January 1, 2013. The provisions related to election notices will be applicable on a date determined by the Department of State.


Brief Description Senate Bill 1572 amends the law regulating police in second class cities by further providing for the residency requirement. This legislation would take effect immediately.
