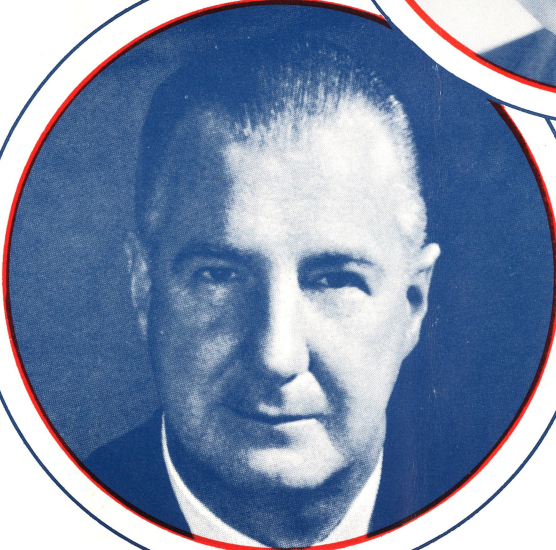

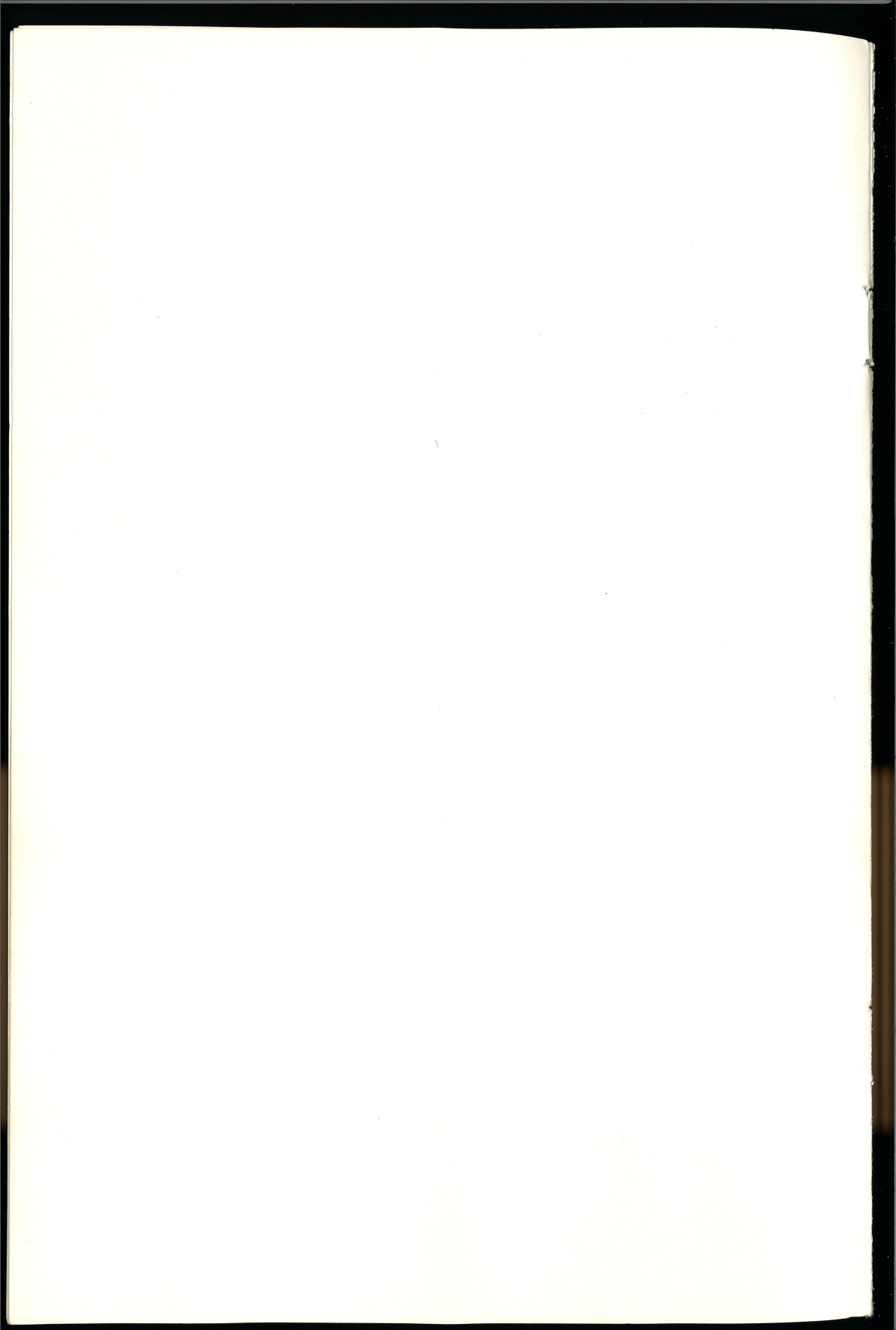

Born: July 12, 1922, Dallas, Oregon, son of C. D. Hatfield, retired railroad construction blacksmith, and Dovie Odom Hatfield, former school teacher.

Education: Willamette Univ. (Salem, Oregon), B.A. 1943; Stanford Univ., M.A., 1948. 19 Honorary Doctorates. Trustee: Willamette Univ., George Fox College.

Service: WW II, U.S. Navy amphibious attack craft—S. Pacific and Far East (Iwo Jima and Okinawa invasions, China Civil War).

Profession: Through ranks instructor-assistant-associate professor, political science, Willamette Univ., 1949-56; Dean of Students 1950-56.

Church: Baptist; Trustee: Western Conservative Baptist Theological Seminary.

Political: State Representative, Marion County, Oregon, 1951-55; State Senator, Marion County, Oregon, 1955-57; Secretary of State, Oregon, 1957-59; Governor, Oregon, 1959-67; U.S. Senator, Oregon, 1967-
