Dear Representative Zug:

Amendment A0324 to House Bill 1018, Printers No. 1193 creates an Emergency Services Fund and establishes a \$.25 monthly surcharge on both land line and wireless phones to provide monies for this fund.

Under the amendment, the proceeds from these surcharges would go directly into the Emergency Services Fund. Moneys in the fund and any interest the fund accrues are to be appropriated annually to the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency (PEMA) to be used for grants to volunteer fire and rescue companies and ambulance services.

Currently, there are approximately 8.5 million land lines and 5 million wireless phones in use in Pennsylvania. Therefore, this amendment would generate approximately \$40 million in new funds. Any administrative costs associated with any grants resulting from this legislation should be minimal. Accordingly, this amendment would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
