The Finance Committee will hold a committee meeting on Tuesday, June 29, 2004 at 9:30 a.m. in Room 39 East Wing. The following legislation will be considered as well as any other business which may come before the committee:

**House Bill 42 (Melio)** – Provides for school district real property tax relief for qualified owners of homesteads or farmsteads.

**House Bill 1019 (Hershey)** – Amends the Solicitation of Funds for Charitable Purpose Act, further providing for audit of certain financial reports.

**House Bill 2383 (Zug)** – Provides for exemption of military personnel from occupational privilege tax.

**House Bill 2741 (Hess)** – Amends the State Lottery Law, further providing for disposition of funds
