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In the near future, I will be introducing legislation, which would increase the income threshold to \$30,000 under the Property Tax and Rent Rebate (PTRR) Program.

The legislation would amend the act known as the Senior Citizens Rebate and Assistance Act, further providing for property tax and rent rebate eligibility. *This legislation does not change the income threshold for claimants seeking a rebate for rent paid. The legislation only increases the threshold for property owners seeking a rebate for property taxes paid.*
