Zug, House Colleagues to Honor Stock Car Star Gerhart

HARRISBURG – Professional stock car driver and Lebanon County native Bobby Gerhart will be honored at the State Capitol on Tuesday, June 7 by Rep. Peter Zug (R-Lebanon) and the Pennsylvania House of Representatives.

Gerhart, a veteran of the ARCA/RE/MAX stock car series, won that series' season-opening race at Daytona International Speedway on Feb. 12, becoming only the second ARCA driver in history to be a three-time winner at Daytona. Gerhart also took the checkered flag at Daytona in 1999 and 2002.

Zug will hold a press conference in the Capitol Rotunda at 9:30 a.m. prior to honoring Gerhart on the House floor and presenting him with a copy of the House resolution. Gerhart and his #5 Lucas Oil Chevrolet will be featured at the press conference.

Others expected to attend the event are Gerhart's brother and crew chief, Billy Gerhart; Joseph Mattioli, chief executive officer and chairman of the board of Pocono Raceway; Rose Mattioli, secretary treasurer of Pocono Raceway; Don Radebaugh, media and public relations director of ARCA; Andy Papathanassiou, director of driver development of Hendrick Motorsports; and members of Gerhart's crew.

"It will be a distinct pleasure and privilege to honor Bobby Gerhart, a great competitor and the pride of Lebanon County," Zug said. "Over the years, he has carved out a great career in stock car racing, while winning the respect and support of the racing community."

The 46-year-old driver has 186 career ARCA starts since 1988, with four career wins and 37 Top Five finishes. His best finish in the ARCA season points standings came in 1999 when he placed third. This season, Gerhart currently is 25th in the points standings.

Gerhart also has made 28 career starts in NASCAR Nextel Cup (formerly Winston Cup) dating back to 1985. His best finish in stock car racing's top level was a 17th place finish at North Wilkesboro in 1987.

Gerhart, who began his racing career on central Pennsylvania dirt tracks like Linda's Speedway and Susquehanna Speedway, also has competed on the NASCAR Busch series, the NASCAR Craftsman Truck series, and the NASCAR Busch North and NASCAR Winston West circuits.

Like the Pettys, Earnhardts and Allisons, Gerhart comes from a racing family. His father, Bobby Gerhart Sr., was a well-known driver regionally and was a profound influence on his son.

"Bobby has carried on his family's racing legacy with pride, and for that, as well as for his stellar racing career, I look forward to honoring him in the House of Representatives," Zug said.
