SUBJECT: Proposed DUI Legislation – Lowering “per se” BAC to .08
(Previously House Bill 642)

I intend to reintroduce legislation (formerly House Bill 642) which will lower the DUI “legal limit” to the .08 level. Many organizations, including the U.S. Department of Transportation’s National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) have been encouraging states to make it illegal “per se” (by itself) if a person has a blood alcohol concentration of .08 or more.

There are life-saving benefits associated with the reduction of the legal limit for blood alcohol. A NHTSA analysis of the effects of .08 in five states has revealed significant decreases in alcohol-related fatalities in four of those states since laws went into effect.
