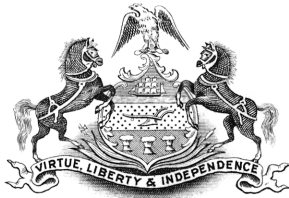


Dear Jim:
