Dear Colleague:

On Wednesday, May 9, I will introduce the Governor's proposed budget. The proposal is revenue neutral and requires no tax increase due to a healthier than expected revenue surplus. While the surplus is healthier than expected, it is still not large enough to cover all priorities. Keep in mind that the Governor's budget does not support all the programs reflected in the 2006/07 spending plan approved by the General Assembly last year. The introduced budget simply reflects a starting point.

All amendments must be revenue neutral under House Rule 19B. In other words, an increase in spending must be offset by a corresponding decrease in spending. In order to be timely filed, amendments must be posted to the bill no later than 2 pm, Monday, May 14. If you want assistance drafting amendments, please contact my office no later than noon, Friday, May 11.

This is not an easy budget. **We still face difficult decisions: revenue limitations combined with the demand to restore programs and priorities not contained in the Governor's proposed 2007/08 budget must be addressed.**

Voting on the budget bill will occur during the week of May 21.

SUBJECT: CO-SPONSORSHIP OF LEGISLATION: PARAMEDIC TRAINING

In the coming weeks, I plan to reintroduce a proposal aimed at providing much needed financial assistance to our local police departments and EMS Organizations.

Previously House Bill 1016 of the 2005-06 session, this legislation establishes a loan program for local police agencies and EMS organization throughout the Commonwealth through the issuance of a bond. The Governor's Center for Local Government Services within the Department of Community and Economic Development will administer this program with the bond proceeds to be deposited into a new fund called the Police Agency and EMS Organization Loan Fund.
