Rep. Tangretti Remarks Italian Heritage Society

(Usual Greetings and Acknowledgments)

Thank you very much, (name), for that generous introduction.

I'm truly honored, and somewhat at a loss for words, to fully express my gratitude for this award...and for being named to this select company of distinguished recipients.

It's especially gratifying to know that proceeds from this event will benefit the Clelian Heights School for Exceptional Children in Greensburg.

So I would like to thank everyone involved with tonight's banquet and everyone connected with the Italian Heritage

Society for the multitude of benefits that flow from their activities and from their spirit of generosity.

Maybe what's most valuable about events like this is that it

reflects the society's commitment to preserving our Italian heritage in the modern world -- a world where ideas of what constitutes progress often conflict with traditional beliefs, values and cultures.

Our vision of what makes up the ideal American society, for example, has changed a great deal in our lifetimes. Changed from the ideal of "the American melting pot" in which ethnic identities would blend into a harmonious mixture with each contributing something of value to the whole ... to, more recently, the emergence of "multiculturalism" which claims that the primacy of America's European heritage must yield to something like an "equal time" provision for other non-European cultural perspectives.

America's new role as the unchallenged global leader might be said to justify the broader perspective that

multiculturalism encourages. But must it come at the expense of other traditions and their claims to cultural respect?

To the concern of many of us, particularly Italian-Americans, this question surfaced dramatically during the recent events involving the 500th Anniversary of Columbus's voyages and discoveries.

What might have been...and should have been...an occasion for national pride and celebration, especially among Italian-Americans, was instead observed almost reluctantly, even apologetically, by much of the nation's media and among other establishment circles.

So I again commend the Italian Heritage Society for its efforts to strengthen our pride in the contributions that Italy's sons and daughters have made to Pennsylvania and to America. And not just to this state or this nation, but everywhere in the
