- B. WE MUST NEVER BE ASHAMED OF WHAT WE DO OR BE
 AFRAID TO DEMAND EQUAL PAY WITH OUR COUNTER
 PARTS IN THE PRIVATE SECTOR
 - 1. LET US NOT EVER EMBRACE THE ILLUSION THAT

 MANY IN THE MEDIA AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR

 PRESENT THAT WE ARE ONLY THERE TO SERVE THE
