New office to aid Union City residents

Harrisburg April 2— State Rep. Tom Scrimenti, D-Erie, is pleased to announce that on Wednesday, April 2, he will begin holding afternoon office hours in Union City as a service to his constituents in that area.

Every Wednesday from 1 to 4 p.m., individuals can find information on any state-related issue at the new office at the Northwest Savings Bank, 22 N. Main St.

Scrimenti's other two constituent service offices are in North East and Corry.

"We were very lucky to receive this space through a donation from the bank as a public service to the residents of Union City," Scrimenti said. "I wanted to offer this as an alternative to people in the area because it is difficult for anyone without transportation to travel to my Corry office."

Due to shifts in legislative districts, state Sen. Bob Robbins no longer represents Union City and closed the office he had in the area. Scrimenti said that move influenced his decision to offer office hours in Union City.

"Residents can get state forms of all kinds during these hours and find answers to state-related questions through my knowledgeable staff," Scrimenti said. "Anything that would be found or performed in my other offices will also be offered in Union City every Wednesday afternoon."

Scrimenti said the office will provide brochures, literature and forms on everything from higher education to programs for seniors to state income tax guidelines.
