artistic success -

and desires to express herself through painting,
drama, dancing, writing, music - recognizes her
success by her own feelings and through recognition
by other artists and experts -

My definition as it relates to my remarks
scholarship is knowledge and learning attained
by involvement, supported and initiated by commitment
and the result or the impact is the degree of
relevancy or application of the scholar to the
society - community - as would in which he lives.

The focal point in any discussion on the
attainment of successful scholarship is you. You
are the designer and you must chart the course -
Your interest, your motivation, your ability, your commitment, your weaknesses.
Your physical energies, your self-demand, your lets & type of learning, your
commitment, your involvement + ultimately your ability to make
relevant your knowledge is the basis on which you determine
your level of scholarship - Bloom

Have you expected something for nothing - what
did you bring to the classroom?

~~Students may~~ Let us look at Jane - Was AZ popular -
attractive - ARA - spokeswoman in SGA - Oh. of College twin - but
no-one mentions her academic involvement + academic success -
maybe some believe she's just made a 2.0 rather than her
actual 2.98- or 3.0. The picture of Jane's social success, success
in her field could never have been accomplished had she
neglected her studies - The "college experience" can never
replace the involvement in scholarship

many may say — They learn more out of
the classroom than in it — That college life
more the real teacher — (st. affairs) — Perhaps
those who learned more in "college life" put more
involvement in trial + effect in this area.

The success of achievement ^{your} in academic + college
life is the successful budget of ^{your} time + ^{your} energies toward
a well-balanced schedule of eating, sleeping, studying, + relaxing.
Don't try to continually mix these activities — realize
your priorities — plan accordingly — If you fail in
achievement in academics + scholarshiply you have
no opportunity for part. in college life.

In the attainment of academic success develop an understanding of your self and your abilities Since ~~learning~~ is the ~~base~~ Academic success involves learning - let's examine various types of learning -

1. Trial + error — behavior changes because mistakes to do something makes errors + by accident finds a solution

Ex - Minie tries on several hats to find one

that fits - $6\frac{3}{4}$
 $6\frac{3}{8}$ - $6\frac{3}{4}$ remember something by repeating until remembered

3. Association - learn something new by associating it with something already remembered
telephone number ends in 638

4. Conscious problem solving - follow plan of action to solve problem produces greater learning because based on previous learning
acts - wks. to memorize her head.

5. Unconscious insight - learning without consciously trying to solve problem - tries on hats - does not feel size - gets home - later in day - why not ask Salesgirl to memorize her head.
