SUBJECT: Resolution Cosponsorship

Recently, the Aging and Older Adult Services Committee held public hearings on the Older Adult Protective Services Law and the Protective Services System. Throughout the course of those hearings, it became apparent to me that there exists a very vulnerable population of citizens in the Commonwealth who do not have the protections afforded to them as do children and older adults.

Currently, individuals ages 18 through 59 in the Commonwealth who are at imminent risk of injury or death due to a physical or cognitive impairment, neglect, abuse or other incapacitating condition have no program of protective services available to them. Although many of these individuals are hard working, productive citizens, they are particularly vulnerable to injury or death from neglect or abuse as a result of some impairment or incapacitating condition. Given the success of our Child Protective Services and Older Adult Protective Services Systems in raising awareness on and combating the incidences of abuse and neglect, I believe that we need to examine the need for such a system to protect individuals between the ages of 18 and 59.

I am proposing a resolution that will direct the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to conduct a study to examine the need for protective services for adults 18 to 59 years of age and to report back to the General Assembly with their findings and recommendations on how best to meet the needs of these vulnerable citizens.
