Thank you for contacting me regarding the Fiscal Year 2000 funding levels for Social Services Block Grants (SSBG). It is good to hear from you.

Congress recently passed H.R. 3194, the Consolidated Appropriations Act. This bill was the result of numerous hours of deliberations between the Administration and the House and Senate members. Included in this legislation was funding for the SSBG program at \$1.775 billion. I understand the importance of this critical program for the people of Pennsylvania, but unfortunately, the funding level did not attain the \$2.3 billion that you had requested. Be assured that when this issue comes up next year, I will keep your views in mind.
